Toro announces dates for Wiluna uranium project public information days in regional WA

The dates for public information days in regional Western Australia about the Wiluna uranium project have been announced by project owner and developer, Toro Energy Limited (ASX: "TOE").

The four day program commences in the Goldfields from next Monday, 15 August. The venues and times for the information days are as follows:

A project display and information sheets will be available at each venue, with members of Toro Energy's Wiluna uranium project team also in attendance to discuss project details.

"Toro considers that the information days in regional Western Australia are an important part of the public assessment of Wiluna's Environmental Review and Management Programme (ERMP)", Toro Energy's Managing Director, Mr Greg Hall, said today.

"The ERMP documentation was presented earlier this year to the Western Australian and Federal Governments for their initial assessment. The information days are designed for local communities to access information first-hand about the Project, and facilitate their understanding of what it involves. This will enable best use of the current 14 week assessment period by the public to provide comment to government about the ERMP," Mr Hall said.

The public comment period closes on 31 October. Advertisements promoting the days will be placed with local press this week.

Mr Hall said the information days would provide regional communities the opportunity to talk directly to members of the project team about any issues or concerns local residents may have.
